24,000 dogs set to return for Crufts

The 2023 event will see more than 200 breeds in contention for the famous Best in Show trophy, which will be awarded live on Channel 4 on the evening of Sunday 12 March.

Leading the field with the most entries for Crufts 2023 is the great family favourite, the Labrador, with 537 dogs hoping to be crowned Best in Show 2023. This is just ahead of the Golden Retriever (491) and the Whippet (400).

The number of breeds competing at the UK's annual celebration of dogs continues to grow, adding to the diversity of the event, with the Bavarian Mountain Hound making history and having its own breed class for the first time, with six dogs hoping to take the title.

This year has also seen an increase of 50 per cent or more in the entries for the Kerry Blue Terrier, Norwegian Elkhound, Japanese Akita Inu and English Toy Terrier compared with 2022. In contrast, the Komondor and the Swedish Lapphund have drawn just one entry apiece, which highlights that the show is a true celebration of all dogs, from the well-known to the highly unusual.

Crufts also continues to maintain its international flavour with over 3,000 dogs from overseas contending for the Best in Show title, with France leading the way with 398 dogs, just ahead of last year's frontrunner Italy (387).

As well as the individual breed classes which lead to Best in Show, visitors can watch some of the world's fastest and smartest dogs in action with agility and obedience championships, and enjoy unique canine relay in the flyball competitions. Elsewhere, The Kennel Club Hero Dog Award celebrates five special dogs who provide lifetime service to society, and support, love and devotion to owners, and the final

of the nation's favourite crossbreed competition, Scruffts, will take place. The Discover Dogs area showcases hundreds of different breeds for would-be owners to meet close-up and find out more about.

For 2023, there is a record-breaking 16 hours and 30 minutes of Crufts coverage on Channel 4 and More4 this March, from Thursday 9 to Sunday 12. With Clare Balding at the helm once again, Channel 4 and More4 will broadcast all the action from the show, leading up to the grand finale on Sunday when Best in Show will be crowned.

Clare will host daily highlights of the world's most famous dog event live from the NEC and will be joined by a team of reporters including Radzi Chinyanganya and, returning for her second year, Sophie Morgan, along with canine experts who will be covering the show.

Vanessa McAlpine, Crufts Show Manager, said: "Every dog has its day at

Crufts and we look forward to welcoming dogs, owners and visitors from all over.

"The event really does offer something for all dog-lovers, from meeting and greeting the vast and diverse range of wonderful breeds there are, including some of the more unusual that are not often seen in the streets and parks across the country, through to getting closer to the action with exciting canine competitions and the dog show aspect, with the prestigious Best in Show finale.

"We're delighted that Channel 4 and More4 are offering viewers at home the opportunity to enjoy this year's Crufts with the most coverage since the show was first televised in 1950! The programme will include something for everyone, with topics about choosing, caring for and enjoying life with a four-legged friend, as well as different issues affecting dog owners in the UK."

Judges announced for the Junior Open Agility World Championships

The Kennel Club is pleased to announce that the FCI has formally approved the following judges to judge at the Junior Open Agility World Championships later this year.

Lee Gibson and Natalie Webb from the United Kingdom, Jirina Mackova from Czech Republic and Kurt Ove Steinset from Norway have been appointed as agility judges for the championships which is one of the world's most prestigious international dog

agility competitions. It is open to competitors aged 18 and under with both pedigree and non-pedigree dogs that have been selected to represent their country and will take place 12-16 July at Dallas Burston Polo Club in Southam.

This is the first time the UK has held the competition and heralds the first of

two events to be hosted by The Kennel Club, with the European Open

Championships in 2024 due to be held at Rutland Showground in Oakham.

Club, said: "The Kennel Club would like to congratulate the judges on their appointments at the

Junior Open Agility World Championships in July.

The Kennel Club and Scottish SSPCA join forces with North East Scotland MSP to call for ban on electric shock collars

The Kennel Club and Scottish SPCA have welcomed a recent motion, tabled by Maurice Golden, Scottish Conservative and Unionist Party MSP for North East Scotland, that calls on the Scottish Government to introduce a ban on the use of electric shock dog collars.

Electric shock collars are devices that deliver an electric shock to the dog's neck via a remote control, up to a radius of two miles – meaning a dog not within sight of its owner could still receive the stimulus - and for up to 11 seconds at a time. The Kennel Club has long-campaigned for a ban on these devices, alongside SSPCA, RSPCA, Battersea Dogs & Cats Home, the British Veterinary Association and Blue Cross. Wide-ranging evidence has demonstrated the detrimental effect these can have on the welfare of dogs and, in 2019, a study carried out by the University of Lincoln showed that electric shock collars were no more effective in training than positive reinforcement and dogs' well-being was compromised, even when used by 'professional' e-collar trainers. They have been banned in Wales since 2010 under The Animal Welfare (Electronic Collars) (Wales) Regulations and this month the French Government has also banned these aversive devices.

Following extensive research and a public consultation, the Scottish

Government introduced Guidance condemning the use of shock collars in 2018, and hailed this an 'effective ban' on the use of these devices. However the Guidance has since proven to be ineffective in stopping the use of these devices and, as a result, Maurice Golden MSP has tabled a motion calling on the Scottish Government to introduce Regulations to ban their use.

Maurice Golden MSP said: "Electric shock collars are not only harmful to our pets, but extensive research has clearly shown that they fundamentally do not fix the cause of 'undesirable' behaviour.

"The use of these inappropriate training devices is unacceptable and we urgently need tougher Regulations that prohibit the use of them completely."

Mark Beazley, Chief Executive at The Kennel Club said: "The Kennel Club has long campaigned for a ban on electric shock collars and we are pleased to see that Maurice Golden MSP has brought the issue forward once again in the Scottish Parliament.

"We were delighted when the Scottish Government pledged to ban the use of these devices in 2018. Unfortunately, this has since proven to be ineffective, and as such we believe that Regulations

urgently need to be introduced in order to stop the unnecessary suffering of dogs."

Scottish SPCA chief executive, Kirsteen Campbell, said: "The Scottish SPCA received 47 reports to its animal helpline regarding electric shock collars being used on dogs from 2019 to 2021. In 2021, we conducted a survey of over 2,800 members of the Scottish public and found that 83% of respondents supported a total ban on the use of collars that give a dog an electric shock.

"We have been rehabilitating dogs for decades without using methods that cause fear or pain. The Society has long advocated that only positive reinforcement based training is used for dogs. Electric shock collars can have negative welfare implications, causing physical pain and long-term fear. We applaud the Welsh Government for introducing a ban on e-collars and we hope that Scotland will follow suit and consider more humane methods to address behavioural issues with our dogs."

The Kennel Club and SSPCA are encouraging the public to write to their MSP to urge them to pledge their support for this motion.

Epilepsy webinar a success

The Kennel Club held its second health-specific webinar for owners and breeders, focussed on canine epilepsy and presented by neurology specialist Professor Holger Volk.

The free webinar was fully subscribed, with over 500 people in attendance. Professor Volk covered several areas intertwined with this prevalent condition, including progression of disease, treatment options, dietary factors, what research has told us to date, and how to support owners and dogs living with epilepsy. A Q&A session was also held, giving attendees a chance to put forward their queries and experiences for discussion.

Epilepsy is known to affect a significant number of breeds, and is identified as a priority condition through The Kennel Club's Breed Health and Conservation Plan project for some 35 breeds, equivalent to almost 20% of Kennel Club registered dogs. Sadly, there is no known prevention for this disease, but there are tools and resources available to support affected dogs and their owners.

The webinar was recorded and has been disseminated to all attendees, but those who are interested in receiving a copy can email The Kennel Club health team at health@thekennelclub.org.uk. Hosting this permanently on The Kennel Club's platforms is also being investigated so that this educational piece is widely accessible.

The Kennel Club plans to hold a full series of freely accessible webinars throughout the year and further details surrounding other upcoming webinars will be released at a later date.

Junior Warrant final returns to Crufts

The final of The Kennel Club Junior Warrant Winner of the Year competition will return to Crufts on Thursday 9 March for the first time since 2020, and will be judged by well-known exhibitor Lee Cox who has achieved much success with Poodles, Clumber Spaniels, Chinese Crested and other breeds bred under the Vanitonia kennel name.

The Junior Warrant is an award for pedigree dogs from the ages of six to 18 months which have won a series of first prizes at both open and championship shows. Achieving a Junior Warrant is one of the highest levels of success for young pedigree dogs, and under normal circumstances The Kennel Club issues around 600 such awards each year.

The semi-finals of the competition took place in October at London's biggest dog event, Discover Dogs, run by The Kennel Club, with 44 top young dogs competing for just ten places.

Breeders' Competition finalists to take centre stage at Crufts 2023

The final of The Kennel Club Breeders' Competition will take place at Crufts on Thursday 9 March 2023 at the NEC Birmingham and will be judged by Mr Sigurd Wilberg, who has achieved great success over many years in a number of breeds including Boxers, Bouviers des Flandres, Schnauzers (all three sizes), Miniature Wire Haired Dachshunds, Pointers and Smooth Fox Terriers bred under the Kanix kennel name.

Vulnerable Breeds finalists at Crufts 2023 announced

The names of the dogs which will compete in the final of The Kennel Club Vulnerable British and Irish Breeds Competition at Crufts 2023 have been announced.

The competition is the only one of its kind in the UK, raising awareness of Britain and Ireland's rare native dog breeds and recognising those breeders and owners dedicated to ensuring their continued survival. In 2022, 32 breeds fell into this category, having generated 300 or fewer puppy registrations in the UK in the previous year.

The final will be judged by Patsy Hollings, breeder of the well-known Gunalt Weimaraners. The finalists will parade at 5.45pm in the main arena on Friday 10 March at the NEC in Birmingham. Pre-judging will be conducted in hall 1, ring 5 at 1pm.

In order to qualify for the final, a dog must have won Best of Breed at the group championship show designated by the Kennel Club as the breed's qualifying show. In a small number of instances, the Best of Breed winner's owner has advised that they are unable to compete in the final; in which case, the Best Opposite Sex in Breed winner has been invited to compete in their place to ensure that all breeds are represented and supported.

New DNA testing scheme for Samoyeds

The Kennel Club has approved two new official DNA test reporting schemes for X-linked progressive retinal atrophy 1 (XLPR1) and X-linked hereditary nephritis (XLHN) in Samoyeds, following consultation with the breed's health co-ordinator on behalf of the breed clubs.

XLPR1

XLPR1 is an inherited condition that causes problems with the retina (a layer of light-sensitive tissue at the back of the eye). The retina contains special cells, called photoreceptors, that play a vital role in vision. In affected dogs, their photoreceptors begin to break down, causing vision problems that gradually become worse, sometimes leading to total blindness. Some individuals may be more affected than others.

The disease is described as X-linked, which means that the faulty gene that causes this type of PRA is found on the X-chromosome. The X-chromosome helps to determine a dog's sex.

Male dogs only have one X-chromosome, which they always inherit from their mother, while females have two X-chromosomes, which they inherit from both their mother and father.

In females, the disease acts in a recessive way, i.e., a female must inherit two copies of the faulty gene (one from her mother and one from her father) to be affected.

In males, because they only have a single copy of the X-chromosome, the condition behaves as if it were dominant and male dogs are either healthy (they only have a healthy copy of the gene) or affected (they only have the faulty copy of a gene).

Tested dogs will be recorded on The Kennel Club systems as either:

CLEAR If your dog is clear, they will not have any copies of the faulty gene associated with XL-PRA1 and will only pass on a normal copy of the gene to any offspring.

CARRIER Carriers have one healthy and one faulty version of the gene associated with XL-PRA1. Only females can have two copies of the X chromosome, and so only females can be carriers for XL-PRA1. Despite carrying one copy of the faulty gene, the dog is unlikely to be affected by the condition. When bred from, a carrier has a 50 per cent chance of passing the faulty gene on to her puppies.

AFFECTED A female with two copies of the faulty genes, one inherited from her mother and one from her father, will be affected. An affected male will have a single copy of the faulty gene, which he inherited from his mother.

If bred from, affected females will pass on a copy of this abnormal gene to all their offspring. Any male puppies that inherit the faulty gene will be affected.

Affected males will pass this faulty gene on to all female puppies, but not to male puppies.

XLHN

XLHN is an inherited condition that causes certain parts of a dog's kidneys to become inflamed and stop working correctly. In males, and some females, this progresses to kidney failure and death, often at a young age.

The disease is described as X-linked, which means that the faulty gene that causes this type of nephritis is found on the X-chromosome. The X-chromosome

helps to determine a dog's sex.

Male dogs only have one X-chromosome, which they always inherit from their mother, while females have two X-chromosomes, which they inherit from both their mother and father. In females, the disease acts as an incomplete dominant trait, i.e., if a female is a carrier (has one faulty and one healthy copy of the gene), her health is going to be affected, but not as severely as if both copies of the gene she carries are faulty. In males, because they only have a single copy of the X-chromosome, the condition is dominant and they are either healthy (they only have a healthy copy of the gene), or severely affected (they only have the faulty copy of a gene).

Tested dogs will be recorded on The Kennel Club systems as either:

CLEAR If your dog is clear, they will not have any copies of the faulty gene associated with X-linked nephritis and will only pass on a normal copy of the gene to any offspring.

SINGLE AFFECTED A single affected male will have one copy of the faulty gene, which he inherited from his mother. These dogs are likely to be severely affected by the disorder. If bred from, single affected males will pass a copy of this abnormal gene to all female puppies, causing them to become affected. They will not pass the abnormal gene to their male puppies.

Females can have two copies of the X-chromosome. A single affected female

will have one healthy and one faulty version of the gene associated with X-linked nephritis. The dog is likely to be affected by the condition, although the severity varies between individuals. When bred from, a single affected female has a 50 per cent chance of passing the faulty gene to each of her puppies and so can produce affected puppies.

DOUBLE AFFECTED A double affected female has two copies of the faulty genes, one inherited from her mother and one from her father. These dogs are likely to be severely affected by the disorder. If bred from, double affected females will pass on a copy of this abnormal gene to all of their offspring and so will produce affected puppies.

Please note that these listings are not necessarily comprehensive and other labs may offer the tests. To find out which DNA tests are relevant to your breed, visit thekennelclub.org.uk/breeds.

Please note that due to the way that these conditions are inherited, and the way that The Kennel Club database

currently works, The Kennel Club is not able to record the hereditary status of puppies that are born from two tested dogs.

The Kennel Club constantly reviews DNA testing schemes in conjunction with breed clubs to ensure that breeders are supported with resources which help them to make responsible breeding decisions. The Kennel Club works alongside breed clubs and breed health co-ordinators in a collaborative effort to improve the health of pedigree dogs and is happy to consider a club's request to add a new DNA test to its lists.

A formal request from the breed's health co-ordinator or a majority request from the breed clubs is normally required to do this.

Test results will be added to the dog's registration details which

will trigger the publication of the result in the next available Breed Records Supplement and also on the Health Test Results Finder on The Kennel Club website.

Results for dogs already tested can also be recorded, but owners will need to submit copies of the DNA certificates themselves. DNA test certificates should be scanned and emailed to health.results@thekennelclub.org.uk.

A12 DECISION

**Disciplinary Committee Hearing
15 December 2022
Miss AJ Allinson (Dunbar)
Kennel Club Rule A12**

The Committee having carefully considered the convictions of Miss Amanda Jeanette Allinson (Dunbar) of Grosmont, Whitby for causing

unnecessary suffering offences contrary to the Animal Welfare Act 2006 from the York Magistrates' Court on 26 June 2019.

The Committee impose the following penalties:

1. To disqualify her from exhibiting at, taking part in, attending and/or having any connection with any event licensed by the Club. If any person disqualified under this sub-paragraph shall attend any canine event whilst disqualified the Board shall have the power to increase the period of disqualification [A11 j (4)]
2. To disqualify her from being or becoming a member of any canine club or society registered with or affiliated to the Kennel Club [A11 j (5)]
3. To disqualify her from acting as an Officer or serving on the Committee of any canine society [A11 j (6)]
4. To disqualify her from taking part in the management of any event licensed by the Club [A11 j (7)]
5. To disqualify her from judging at any event licensed by the Club [A11 j (8)]
6. To disqualify her from effecting registrations of any or all dogs and/or progeny of such dogs which are owned and/or registered by her (whether or not jointly owned and/or whether or not owned and/or registered in the name of a nominee) [A11 j (9)]

The suspensions and disqualifications are to be for Life from 15 December 2022.

The Committee noted that Miss Allinson pleaded guilty to charges of causing unnecessary suffering to 19 dogs and 3 cats, namely by failing to meet their need for a suitable environment. Miss Allinson also pleaded guilty to charges of causing unnecessary suffering to a Cocker Spaniel namely by failing to provide proper and necessary coat care and maintenance resulting in excessive matting.

Miss Allinson also pleaded guilty to charges of causing unnecessary suffering to a Shih Tzu namely by failing to provide proper and necessary veterinary care and attention for infected wounds.

The Court imposed a 10 week custodial sentence suspended for 12 months due to the seriousness of the offence and the appalling treatment of animals where Miss Allinson had a duty of care. The Court also imposed a 7 year disqualification from owning or keeping felines.

The Kennel Club is duty bound to follow and at least reflect any period of disqualification given by the Court.

Miss Allison pleaded guilty to offences involving a clear and unacceptable lack of the Animal Welfare Act considerations. This is entirely incompatible with being associated with and using Kennel Club registration facilities. The Committee's view was that a lifetime disqualification from Kennel Club regulated activities is appropriate to reflect the seriousness of the matter.

The Committee's view was that a breeder must ensure that they are fully informed about the breeding requirements and care needed for their animals - and seek help and advice, perhaps from other breeders or sources of authority and veterinary advice.

It is not acceptable to risk the health and welfare of any animal.

As with previous cases involving offences under the Animal Welfare Act 2006 it is worth expressly stating that any breeder must ensure that the needs of an animal must be met to the extent required by good practice under the Animal Welfare Act 2006 including;

- its need for a suitable environment,
- its need for a suitable diet,
- its need to be able to exhibit normal behaviour patterns,
- any need it has to be housed with, or apart from, other animals, and
- its need to be protected from pain, suffering, injury and disease.

We said we would look at the way we govern ourselves, the way we make decisions and delegate responsibility for delivery of certain programmes, projects and tasks. Governance also covers how we work and perform, including our relationships with Members, the Board, committees, working groups and staff. Our Members and staff surveys provided a clear indication that this needs to be done. That way we can continue being relevant and

respected whilst simplifying The Kennel Club and delivering better value for money as a result.

We need a simpler, more accessible, efficient organisation

Why are we doing it?

We know as an organisation we have unnecessary levels of complexity, in terms of our structure, our decision making and our products and services. For example, we have over 40 committees and working parties (some with as many as 50 volunteers in each), and

with that many people, it's inevitable that things can slow down. We really value the precious time our volunteers put into our organisation and which isn't the best use of our volunteers' time or slowing us down and costing us money to ensure that we can continue making a positive difference to dogs and their owners, we need to achieve a simpler, more accessible, efficient organisation. This means people from across all our dog communities will be able to interact with us easily. We will be quicker, more transparent and decisive. Which in turn means we will be using our time and income more effectively, doing more of what matters.

Who is involved?

Over the past few months, the Board, alongside governance experts Mayvin (www.mayvin.co.uk), have been working hand in hand to understand how The Kennel Club currently works, its complexities, the way decisions are made, and even how the Boards itself operates. They've been advised by a diverse group of representatives in our design group including people from the dog press, our Finance Committee and staff. Mayvin have enabled The Kennel Club to be really objective and hold up a mirror to ourselves, to see what we're doing well and where we can do things better.

What have we been doing?

It's been a rigorous process that will give us the best chance to get it right first time. After much consideration including a workshop dedicated to Governance and Organisational Design, the Board has agreed seven principles to guide the new way we govern ourselves, make decisions and include people as we do it. If something doesn't satisfy most of these, then we'll go back to the drawing board and try again. We want to move forward with one way of working that everyone signs up to.

Create clarity and simplicity in roles, responsibilities and lines of accountability across the organisation	<i>Simplify and update the relevant sections of the Red Book</i>
Ensure a diverse range of skills and perspectives representing those whom The Kennel Club seeks to serve	<i>Focus the Board election process on what skills are needed to manage portfolios</i>
Empower staff to work autonomously within clear parameters on a day-to-day basis	<i>Build a culture of trust and collaboration allowing people to manage challenge constructively but still work within their delegated authority</i>
Mitigate and manage conflicts of interest	<i>A really clear definition of what conflict of interest and objectivity is, agreed and upheld by our Board, Members, staff and our customers</i>

What's next?

We've heard from some of you on your initial thoughts about governance through the Dog Activities survey in February, which has been really insightful. We understand that we need to review our entire structure to make sure it is fit for purpose. Going forwards we'll be working with Committees so that everyone has input into agreeing what stays and what needs to change. We are sharing these principles with staff

and have started a series of discussions about what they could mean for them, how this could free them up to make them more effective.

Listening to everyone is important – we are one KC. It's complicated and we know this is taking time, but inclusive change takes longer and lasts longer. By looking at our governance across all levels of the organisation and talking to lots of people, we stand a better chance of identifying all the dependencies and it means we'll get it right first time.
